5. Applications, essays and photographs must be received by January 27, 2003 by 5:00 p.m.
6. Winners will be judged and selected on the basis of their application and essay as they relate to the question, "Why would you like to get married at The McCormick Tribune Ice Rink at Millennium Park?" The winning couple will be chosen on live television on Friday, February 7, 2003.
7. The winning couple must travel to the selected honeymoon destination during the year 2003. Apple Vacations will select and provide the honeymoon.
8. Employees of the Chicago Park District and FOX 32 are not eligible.
