# **Pool Rules & Regulations**

- 1. Obey the lifeguards and follow pool rules. They are there for your safety.
- 2. All persons are required to shower before entering the pool area.
- 3. Food and drink are not permitted in the pool area.
- 4. No smoking allowed in the pool area.
- 5. Clean swimwear is required.
- 6. No running allowed on pool deck.

- 7. Only clean footwear, baby strollers, or wheelchairs are allowed in the pool area.

  Persons in street clothes and street shoes are not allowed on the pool deck.
- 8. Persons with open wounds, excessive sunburn, abrasions that have not healed, or bandages of any kind cannot be allowed in the water.
- 9. Except during Park District classes, SCUBA gear is not allowed in the pool.
- 10. No flotation devices may be used in the pool.
- 11. Family Swim Parents/Guardians must accompany children in the water.
- 12. Children 8 and under, who are not at least 8" taller than the shallow end must be accompanied by an adult.
